IN THIS PROGRAM

The postgraduate orthodontic program, which started in 1977, was up graded in 2012 into an international program taught in English. As a student at the International Postgraduate Orthodontic Program (IPOP) you will benefit from:

- » The broadest clinical and academic training that only the combination of a prestigious university and a world leading medical center can provide.
- » Faculty of more than 20 specialists including world renowned clinicians and researchers.
- » Specialized clinics: early treatment, adult orthodontics, impacted teeth, clefts, orthognathic surgery, special needs, lingual & Invisalign treatments, self-ligating brackets, and treatment of multidisciplinary cases.
- » IPOP meets the academic requirements of the European ERASMUS project and of the European Federation of Orthodontic Specialists Associations. Studies are full time, 5 days per week [Sunday-Thursday]. You will start at least 40 new cases and will continue treatment of many transfer cases.
- » International M.Sc. Program in Biomedical Sciences, including a research project and theoretical courses. On completion of the program, students will be awarded an M.Sc. degree from the Hebrew University in Jerusalem.

You will acquire the advanced skills you need in order to compete in today's increasingly competitive dental services market in your country. You will study in a unique international environment at a prestigious institution in Jerusalem, a city with over 4,000 years of history.

Program description:

IPOP includes the following modules:

- » Pre-clinical core and hands-on courses [including lab training]
- » Courses in clinical orthodontics
- » Patient treatment
- » Research - basic or clinical
- » M.Sc. courses

Tuition:

NIS 130,000 per year (approx. \$35,000, depending on exchange rates). Students will be responsible for their own living expenses and travel and for the purchase of all essential books, personal orthodontic instruments and professional camera.
